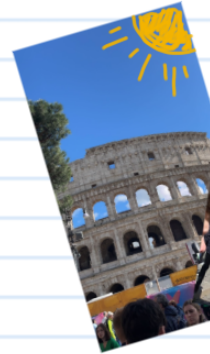

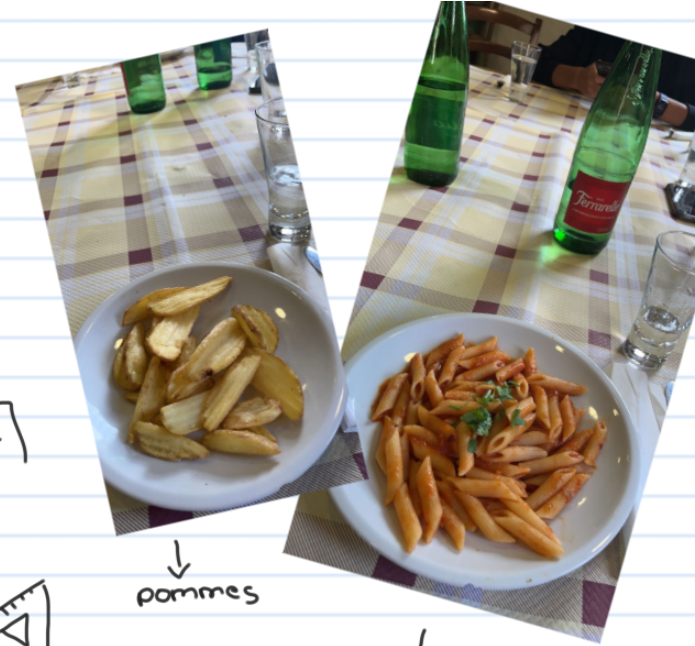
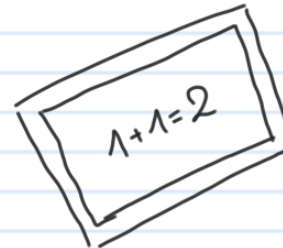
The Scalinata dei Prigionieri Austro-Ungarici in Velletri is a staircase adorned with the names of World War I prisoners of war.

spaghetti arrabiata

→ recipe

Ingredients:

- 1 pound (454g) spaghetti
- 1/4 cup (60ml) extra-virgin olive oil
- 4 cloves garlic, minced
- 1/2-1 teaspoon red pepper flakes (depending on spice preference)
- 1 (28oz/794g) can of whole peeled tomatoes, crushed by hand
- Salt and freshly ground black pepper
- Fresh parsley or basil, chopped (optional)

Instructions:

1. Cook spaghetti in a large pot of salted boiling water until al dente. Drain and set aside, reserving 1 cup of pasta water.
2. Heat olive oil in a large pan over medium heat.
3. Add garlic and red pepper flakes, sauté for about 1-2 minutes until garlic is fragrant.
4. Add crushed tomatoes and season with salt and pepper to taste.
5. Reduce heat to medium-low and simmer the sauce for 15-20 minutes, stirring occasionally.
6. Add cooked spaghetti to the sauce and toss to combine. If the sauce is too thick, add reserved pasta water a little at a time until desired consistency is reached.
7. Serve hot with chopped parsley or basil if desired. Enjoy!

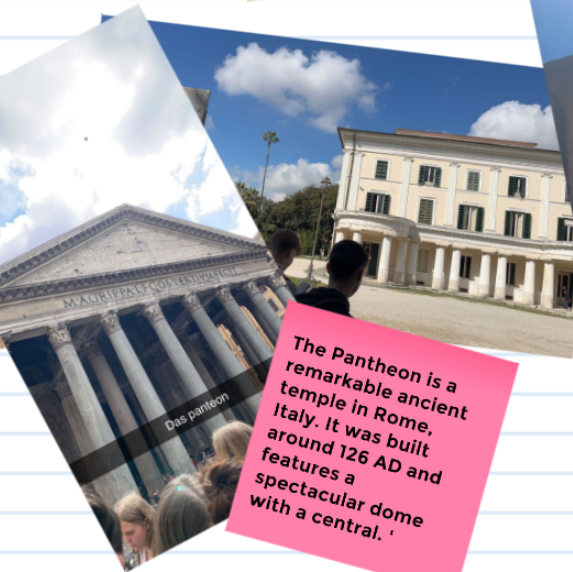

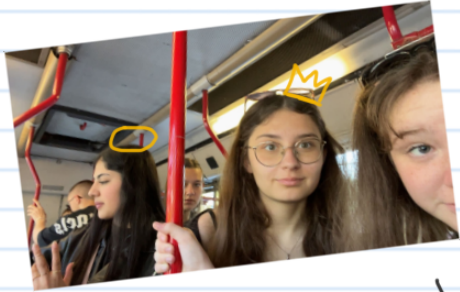


The Pantheon is a remarkable ancient temple in Rome, Italy. It was built around 126 AD and features a spectacular dome with a central oculus.

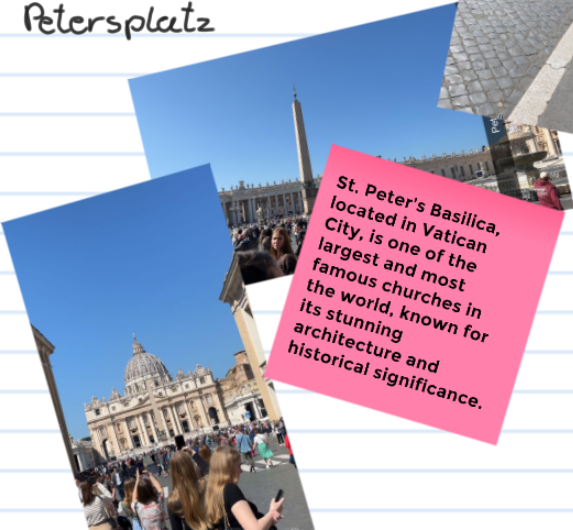

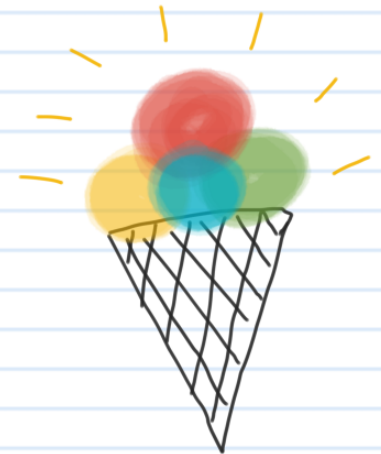


St. Peter's Basilica, located in Vatican City, is one of the largest and most famous churches in the world, known for its stunning architecture and historical significance.
