And the groups who chose a non-digital approach to their game also had a lot of success challenging the younger students on the geography or Europe..



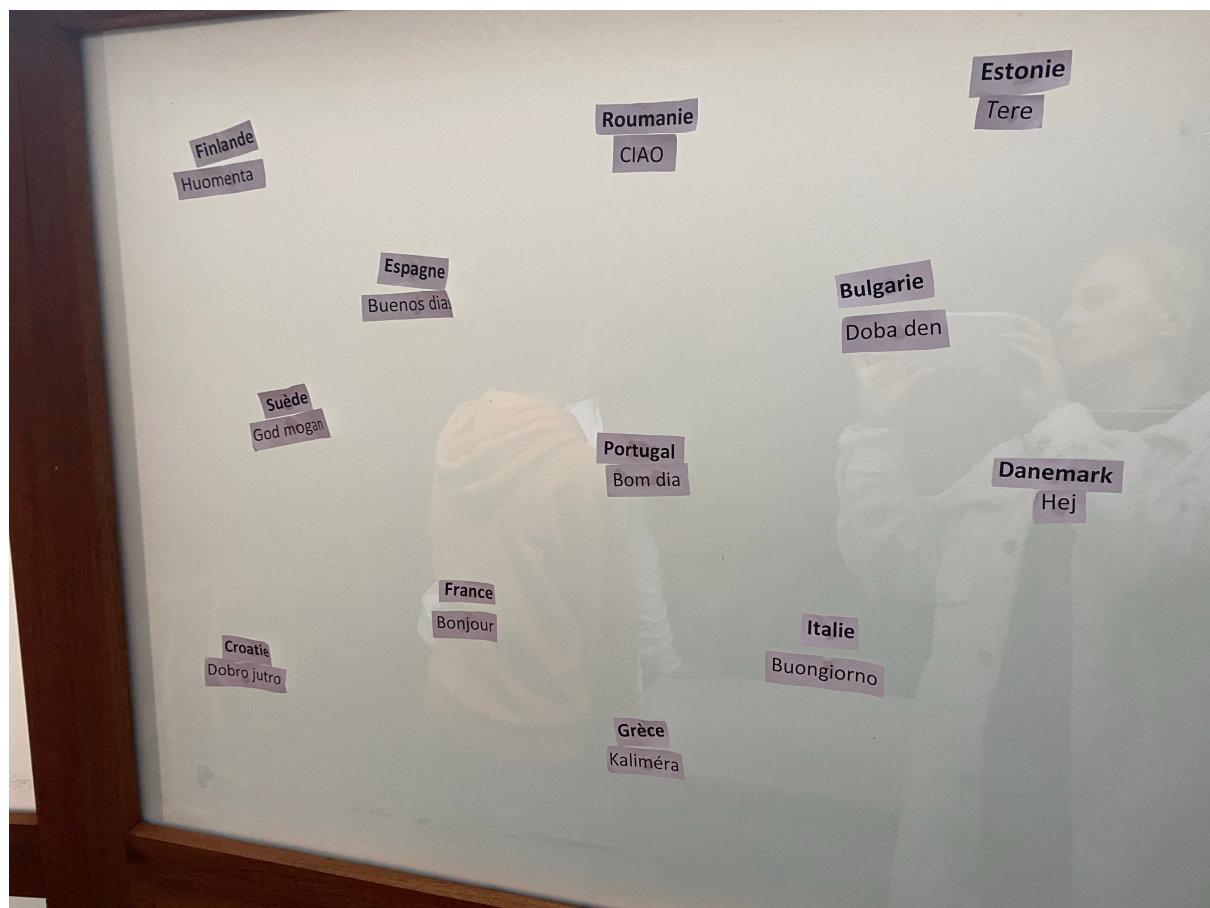
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Another favourite of the students was learning how to say hello in different languages - particularly trying to get the pronunciation right... :)



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
