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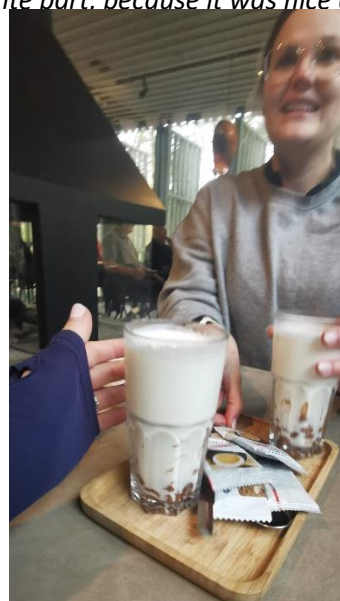

Survey Insight – Saying Goodbye



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In the daily reflection survey, students were asked whether they were sad about the exchange coming to an end. The results show a **mixed picture**:

- **67% (4 out of 6 students)** answered *yes, I am sad*.
- **33% (2 out of 6 students)** answered *no, I'm not sad*.

This reflects both the strong friendships formed during the week and the bittersweet feeling of having to leave after such an intense experience.
