The group departed from Graz and travelled via Zurich to Brussels, where everything went smoothly. Upon arrival in Diest at 16:30, the students were warmly welcomed by their host families. This first evening was dedicated to settling into the host homes and getting to know the families in a relaxed atmosphere.

The feedback from the students about the journey and their first impressions of Belgium was very positive overall. One participant described the host community as “very pleasant, nice people,” while another mentioned that “it is a very beautiful town.” The welcome by the buddies and families was particularly appreciated, with students highlighting how “everyone was very polite and kind” and how they were greeted “with a big smile and good mood.”

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Accommodation was also evaluated positively.
